

## **Hammock Instructions**

A note on the new hammock buckles:

The adjustable webbing suspension now comes with a cinch-type buckle which replaces the older tri-rings. These new buckles are nice because you don't need to tie a backup knot like you did with the tri-rings, however, they can still slip if used improperly.

The webbing needs to be properly aligned. Since the buckle is a little wider than the webbing, you will need to make sure both strands of webbing are stacked directly on top of each other as they enter/exit the buckle rather than in a "v" configuration. The webbing will often come out of proper alignment (and into a "v") while you are making an adjustment, so just make sure its correct when you're done. It shouldn't move out of alignment on it's own, but it can happen while you're pulling on the webbing to make an adjustment.

Secondly, the buckle is not the same on both sides, so the webbing has to be threaded properly. They are sent correctly threaded, however if you ever remove the webbing for any reason, you will need to know how it is supposed to go. Both strands of webbing should be threaded so they drape over and cover the "bison designs llc" logo when in use.
